SUMMARIES

a. Storm water management program status

In 2003, the City of Chippewa Falls began the process of completing a storm water management program. Through a grant that was secured the City of Chippewa Falls has hired a consultant to begin drafting and formulating a management program. The process will continue till a program has been completed and accepted.

b. Enforcement actions, inspections, and other activities

All existing outfalls, catch basins, inlets, storm ponds, and other storm water related infrastructures were examined. Any problems and deficiencies that were found were remedied upon discovery.

c. Program revisions

No information to report.

d. Monitoring data summary

No monitoring was done in the 2003 calendar year. The monitoring proposal was submitted in December of 2003 and is currently under review. Upon acceptance of the monitoring proposal the monitoring program will begin in either 2004 or 2005.

e. Monitoring program revisions

No information to report.

f. Pollutant loading summary

Pollutant loading will be examined in the next calendar year with the development of the SLAMM model for the City of Chippewa Falls. Results from the model will be reported in the year it was developed.

g. Pollution control assessment

The City of Chippewa Falls has actively attempted to reduce sediment loading into its municipal storm water collection system. During this past year catch basins were cleaned, and streets were swept according to the plans submitted under WPDES permit. All existing outfalls were examined and checked for illicit discharges or unusual sediment problems. Any problems that were detected during examination were corrected upon discovery.

Additions to the municipal system include extensions on Wisconsin Street and in the Park West subdivision. Along with the completion of the storm water system in the new subdivision a detention pond was created to help aid in sediment loading.

h. Effluent limitation compliance

Compliance with effluent limitations will be measurable after the storm water model is completed for the City of Chippewa Falls. Once the baseline for contamination levels has been determined the number and effectiveness of the existing BMP's can be measured.

i. Fiscal analysis
