## **PART-TIME EMERGENCY CENTER DISPATCHER JOB OPPORTUNITY**

The Chippewa Falls Police Department will be hiring a Part-Time Emergency Center Dispatcher. The starting rate of pay is \$17.53 per hour. The hours of work available at this time are 10:30 pm to 6:30 am, alternating between two and three days per week. Some additional hours of overtime may be required.

The following minimum qualifications are required:

1. Applicant shall have attained a minimum age of 18.
2. Applicant shall not have been convicted of any federal felony or any offense which if committed in Wisconsin would be punished as a felony.
3. The applicant shall possess a Wisconsin high school diploma or equivalent. "Or equivalent" shall be deemed to mean:
  - a. A diploma issued by an out of state high school accredited by the appropriate agency of the state concerned, or
  - b. The passing of the general education development test or any other test recommended by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction as indicating high school graduation level.
4. Applicant shall be of good character.
5. Applicant shall be free from any physical, emotional, or mental condition which may adversely affect performance of his/her duties as a police dispatcher.
6. Applicant shall be able to communicate effectively.
7. Applicant must have ability to learn to operate teletype computer terminal as well as any other equipment related to the Police Department function. A typing test may be required.
8. Applicants must be able to perform the list of essential functions which is attached to this posting.
