1. Presentations by Normacycle, Veolia, and Waste management regarding recycling options for the City curbside recycling program. (30 minutes each)

Normacycle

Key Takeaways

- Service is Key
- Number of bins and misuse of bins are an issue
- Better bin or cart system would make the program more popular and easier for customer
- Would take \$60K over 3 years to pay for a new cart system
- Could pick up at larger complexes for an added fee
- Apartment buildings should have to purchase or rent containers because of loss

Veolia

Key Takeaways

- Distribute pamphlets on recycling
- Comingled in one container and fiber based (paper/cardboard) in a second
- No single sort stream yet
- Can use 2 – 18 gallon bins every other week (preferred)
- Can use 1 – 18 gallon bin every week
- Would like to include in the RFP an annual fee increase based on a CPI formula
- Would like to include in the RFP a fuel surcharge adjustments (up or down)

Waste Management

Key Takeaways

- Distribute pamphlets on recycling
- Single Sort System (everything in one 96 gallon cart)
- Instructions on Cart on what can go into the container
- Every other week pickup
- Only household recycling in cart
- Bins/Carts would be included in the bid
- Could customize service to use 18 gallon bins

- Normacycle suggested looking into grants for new carts. Rene to check on this.
- Noted that some elderly citizens have trouble getting items out to the street.
- Alternative funding methods was talked about briefly. Some communities add a utility fee or have the hauler charge a fee.
