



**Minutes**  
**Committee #3**  
**Transportation, Construction, Public Safety and Traffic**

**Committee #3 met on Thursday, July 1, 2010 at 4:00 PM in Council Chambers, City Hall, 30 West Central Street, Chippewa Falls, WI.**

Council Members Present: Bill Hicks, CW King, Brian Flynn.

Others Present: City Inspector Paul Lasiewicz, Harvey Fouts, Police Chief Wendy Stelter; Parks & Recreation Director Bill Faherty, Tom Pamperin, Carmen Muenich, Clerk/Treasurer Lynne Bauer.

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 PM

1. Discuss outdoor wood burner moratorium with possible recommendations to the Council.

The Committee discussed the moratorium. No action taken.

2. Discuss request of Harvey Fouts to install a high efficient outdoor wood burner with possible recommendations to the Council.

Motion by Brian/King, all present voting aye, to table the request of Harvey Fouts to install a high efficient outdoor wood burner. Motion carried. The Committee will continue to research this matter and Mr. Fouts will provide technical information to Fire Chief Larson and City Inspector Paul Lasiewicz.

3. Discuss animal control issues within the City with possible recommendations to the Council.

The Committee discussed issues relating to complaints received by the Police Department from the Parks & Recreation Department and citizens about bears, skunks, raccoons and other animals. Police Chief Stelter will review current animal nuisance ordinance and apply that when appropriate. The Committee felt that emergency situations such as a rabid animal should be dealt with immediately by the Police Department.

4. Discuss Safe Routes to School Grant program with possible recommendations to the Council.

Tom Pamperin appeared to discuss the request of Andrew Dane for the City to form a Safe Routes to School Task Force. Motion by Hicks/Flynn, all present voting aye except King who voted nay, to recommend the City Council approve the formation of a Safe Routes to School Task Force for the purpose of pursuing a safe routes to school planning grant and the development of a safe routes to school plan. Motion carried.

5. Discuss possible one-way traffic flow in Irvine Park with possible recommendations to the Council.

The Committee will have the City Engineering Department complete a traffic study in the Park.

6. Discuss removing no parking designation from stalls across from The Ritz located on River Street with possible recommendations to the Council.

The Committee will have Public Works Director Rick Rubenzer check with the Department of Transportation regarding jurisdiction issues.

7. Adjournment

Motion by Hicks/Flynn, all present voting aye, to adjourn at 4:55 PM. Motion carried.
